REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Within the framework of the FIA European Autocross Championship, the organiser will keep managing your entry; however, this will now be centralized in this new platform set by the FIA. Consequently, we would like to draw your attention to the fact that all new information regarding, and any amendments to (as provided for in the Sporting Regulations), your entry must be communicated via the dedicated platform, so that each organiser can access this.

In order to clarify the application process, please find below a few essential points of which you must be aware.

APPLICATIONS

- ✓ Applications to participate in the FIA European Autocross Championship shall be submitted by means of the online entry form available on the following link: <https://registrations.fia.com/autocross>.
- ✓ Applications that have not been submitted online and/or by the given deadlines for the competition concerned will not be taken into consideration.
- ✓ When submitting an entry, the Competitor and/or Driver must provide:
 - Copies of the Competitor's and Driver's Licences,
 - A copy of the duly signed entry form (to be sent by email to the concerned organiser),
 - The proof of payment of entry fee to the organiser concerned, by bank transfer to the bank account details stated on the PDF confirmation.

→ Only dossiers respecting the above requirements, and which are complete, will be taken into consideration.

ELIGIBLE DRIVERS & COMPETITORS

SUPERBUGGY CATEGORY

- ✓ Competitors must hold valid International Competitor's Licences and the necessary applications (visas) issued by their ASNs affiliated to the FIA.
- ✓ Drivers must hold a valid international Driver's and Competitor's licences with a grade C as a minimum, and the necessary authorisations (visas) issued by their ASNs affiliated to the FIA. It can be that the authorisation is part of the licence itself (please check your licence).

BUGGY1 600 & TOURINGAUTOCROSS CATEGORIES

- ✓ Competitors must hold valid International Competitor's Licences and the necessary applications (visas) issued by their ASNs affiliated to the FIA.
- ✓ Drivers must hold valid international Driver's and Competitor's licences with a grade D as a minimum, and the necessary authorisations (visas) issued by their ASNs affiliated to the FIA. It can be that the authorisation is part of the licence itself (please check your licence).

JUNIORBUGGY CATEGORY

- ✓ Competitors must hold valid International Competitor's Licences and the necessary applications (visas) issued by their ASNs affiliated to the FIA.
- ✓ Drivers must hold valid international Driver's and Competitor's licences with a grade Junior-D or Grade D as a minimum, and the necessary authorisations (visas) issued by their ASNs affiliated to the FIA. It can be that the authorisation is part of the licence itself (please check your licence).
- ✓ Drivers must be aged between 13 years old (reaching the 13th birthday during the calendar year) and 21 years old although it will be allowed to complete the stated season.

CALENDARS, LIMITATIONS & DEADLINE



ENTRY FEES



As provided for in Article III c) of the Supplementary Regulations for Competitions of the FIA European Autocross Championship, applications to participate in the Championship must be submitted on the following deadlines:

- The entry fee is:

- 1st closing date of entries (set by the organiser and stated on the Supplementary Regulations)
220€ (Entry fee 170€ + 50€ paddock fee – all included)
- 2nd closing date of entries (set by the organiser and stated on the Supplementary Regulations)
275€ (Entry fee 225€ + 50€ paddock fee – all included)
- After 2nd closing date of entries
440€ (Entry fee 390€ + 50€ paddock fee – all included)

No amendments may be made to an entry, once submitted, except as provided for in the 2019 FIA European Autocross Championship Sporting Regulations. The Competitor may freely replace the car declared in the Entry Form with another from the same division, up to the point of scrutineering.
